**PROGRAM NAME:** **Sankofa Academy - High School**

**Duration:** Six-weeks, June 1, 2010 – July 9, 2010

**Orientation:** Sunday, May 30, 2010 (Mandatory for student participant and at least one parent or guardian)

**Time:** 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. ( non-residential program)

**Description:** The Sankofa Academy is a six-week, academic enrichment program that emphasizes critical thinking, mathematics, English, and college preparation for high school students. The academic enrichment courses give students the opportunity to prepare for future studies. The seminar class enables students to learn about the characteristics of highly successful people. The career-college planning requirement enables students to explore career opportunities and design a blueprint for success. Participants in this program receive daily assignments and graded reports. The enrollment for the Sankofa Academy High School commuter program is ninety (90) students. The number may be 45 students from each high school campus or any combination that equals a total of ninety (90).

**Criteria:** Participants must be entering the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall. Judgment, character, and particularly intellectual accomplishments are among the criteria for selection. Participants must have an acceptable school disciplinary record and must report recent ACT or SAT scores (taken within the last year). Students who have not taken the ACT or SAT must take the ACT in June of the application year. U.S. citizenship or permanent residency is required.

**Cost:** The program is free to selected students who attend Northeast High School and Southern University Laboratory School. Students who do not attend a 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC school must pay a non-refundable fee of \$1,500.

The academic enrichment courses give students the opportunity to prepare for future studies. The seminar class enables students to learn about the characteristics of highly successful people. The enrollment for the Sankofa Academy Middle School program is one hundred (100) students.

**Criteria:** Participants must be entering the 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grade in the fall. Judgment, character, and particularly intellectual accomplishments are among the criteria for selection. Participants must have an acceptable school disciplinary record and must report recent standardized test scores e.g. LEAP, iLEAP, EXPLORE, ACT or SAT scores (taken within the last year).

**Cost:** The program is free to selected students who attend **Capitol Middle School, Northeast Middle School, Broadmoor Middle School, Park Forest Middle School, Southern Laboratory School, and Valley Park Middle School**. Students who do not attend a 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC school must pay a non-refundable fee of \$1,500.

**Duration:** Two weeks, June 7, 2010 – June 18, 2010 (pre-test: Friday, June 4, 2010)

**Orientation:** Sunday, May 30, 2010 (Mandatory for student participant and at least one parent or guardian)

**Time:** 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 Noon (non-residential program)

**Description:** The YES! Academy is a two-week, academic enrichment program that emphasizes critical thinking, mathematics, English, and college preparation for high school students. The academic enrichment courses give students the opportunity to prepare for future studies. The enrollment for the YES! Academy High School commuter program is fifty (50) students. The number may be 10 students from each high school campus or any combination that equals a total of fifty (50) students.

**Criteria:** Generally, students who are eligible for free or reduced-price lunch and are enrolled in Title I schools that have been placed on the state's "in need of improvement" list for two or more years are eligible to receive *free supplemental educational services*. Our participants must be current 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade students attending **Northeast High School, Tara High School, Istrouma High School, East Baton Rouge Acceleration Academy, and Valley Park High School**. U.S. citizenship or permanent residency is required.

**Cost:** The program is free to selected students who attend **Northeast High School, Tara High School, Istrouma High School, East Baton Rouge Acceleration Academy, and Valley Park High School**. Students who do not attend a 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC school must pay a non-refundable fee of \$1,500.
