PROGRAM NAME: Undergraduate Research Program (URP)

- Duration:** Renewable each year, for four (4) years, based on academic performance while pursuing undergraduate degree.
- Description:** URP is a systemic mentoring program, including financial support, research participation, and guidance to graduate school for high achieving undergraduate students majoring in STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) disciplines. A college GPA of 3.0 or above, a minimum of 15 hours per semester, participation in research (academic year and summer), weekly seminar attendance, and GRE preparation are some essential conditions for continued support. URP is funded in part by the Department of the Navy, the Office of Naval Research (ONR), and others.
- Criteria:** Must major in a STEM discipline. Judgment, character, and particularly intellectual accomplishments are among the criteria for selection. For incoming freshmen, standardized tests (ACT/SAT) carry a weight higher than other “measures” of scholarship. United States citizenship required.
- Cost:** Enrollment fees (i.e., tuition, room/board, and fees).
